REPORTS The Transitional Executive Presbytery reported the following:

- 1. The **August hybrid presbytery** was well attended and enjoyable.
- 2. Walk through the new website tool for connection. Rev. Craig Goodwin, who is joining our presbytery as a member at large, has graciously given permission to use his professional photography on the new website.

The Treasurer's Report was made by ErrolLynne Marsh, who spoke for the treasurer.

- 1. Olympia Presbytery is \$30,000 behind budget. \$20,000 of that is a grant that has not come from the PCUSA. The rest is per capita
- 2. Investments fluctuated down. Cash flow is tight. Checking is below the minimum amount. Asked Morgan Stanley for a distribution to come into checking.
- The 2023 budget will be discussed at the December meeting.
- 4. Cynthia Stelle, the bookkeeper, is a good **resource** for congregations.

The Stated Clerk reported the following:

- 1. Report of the **Permanent Judicial Commission** [See attachment]At the March 2022 Olympia Presbytery meeting, State Clerk Kari McFarland notified the presbytery of an accusation against a minister member. Steps were taken, guided by the Book of Order's Discipline section. This is the outcome and decision: The Rules of Discipline give the Church direction in The Preamble (The Principles of Church Discipline)
- 2. The Investigative Committee has been guided by this to provide support in this difficult case. They and the Permanent Judicial Committee did faithful work.
- 3. The Stated Clerk read the charge and censure. Minister member will receive supervised rehabilitation in coordination with the Executive Presbyter. The censure ended with Dexter Kearny reading a prayer written by Rev. Bob Bidwell for this occasion.

Commission on Preparation for Ministry

Dexter Kearny invited Liaison Mike Moffit (UPPC) to speak for CPM and **Inquirer Nate Humphreys**, under care of Westminster PC. Nate met the CPM on 14 September about moving to candidacy. He earned a dual degree from Columbia Theological Seminary, an MDiv and an MA in Practical Theology with an Emphasis on Pastoral Care. He won a scholarship for the Best Paper Showing Sound Theological Scholarship.

Nate was welcomed to speak by the Moderator.

Following questions by presbyters, the moderator closed debate. Nate was placed in a breakout room.

The **MOTION** came from CPM: To approve Nate Humphreys as a candidate for **Ministry of Word and Sacrament** in the PCUSA.

No Discussion

42 yes. Motion passed unanimously.

Nate answered the two official questions in the affirmative as he moved from inquiry to candidacy. A prayer was offered, and Nate was received as a candidate. Applause.

Mike Moffitt led the virtual laying on of hands.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

Update from the **Reset Group** by Barlow Buescher

The Reset Group is bringing in voices to move forward with Native People and the camp.

Update from the Church Discernment Task Force about Skyline Presbyterian Church

Joyce Emery (Bethany) Moderator of the CDTF [formed by the Leadership Council in May] made a report about the task force work to this point.

The 3 focus points:

- 1. Caring for members (Bo Helmich contract through 12/31/2),
- Building management (4.2 acres in Tacoma maintained by Billy Shillinglaw, held in trust by the presbytery, \$5,500/mo to maintain),
- 3. The relationship with neighbors around Skyline

There is no income stream.

The Task Force asked the Presbytery to **end its work** and **constitute an Administrative Commission** with the authority and powers in a motion coming in the report from COM. The major work is to decide what to do with the property and to formally close the church with the PCUSA and end the incorporation with the State of Washington.

REQUESTS FOR

The Task Force asked the Presbytery to share broadly a <u>Requests for Proposals</u> from the public and presbytery at large. From online. Moderator Dexter Kearny thanked the task force.

Commission on Ministry Report by Ken Sikes

MOTION: To form an Administrative Commission to **dissolve the congregation of Skyline Presbyterian Church** and to take appropriate care of the membership rolls, to provide pastoral care for the membership and faithful adherents as they discern where their new church home will be.

The Pastor for Realignment will serve as an ex officio member of the AC through Dec 31, 2022.

Additional duties:

- 1. To consider whether, and when, to order an appraisal for market value sales analysis and income analysis,
- 2. To consider incoming proposals and make recommendations to Presbytery in the first quarter of 2023.
- 3. Ultimately, make recommendations about the property.
- 4. Close the congregation at the next presbytery meeting by a simple motion.
- Attend to all financial issues as necessary.
- 6. Attend to all the judicatory issues as required.
- 7. And to recommend a separate AC for the purpose executing the proposal chosen.

All expenses associated with the work of the AC come from the proposed sale of a presbytery property or another feasible way of covering the cost to Presbytery. If requested by the AC, the Leadership Council may add two additional members to the AC.
